Brake or Break?

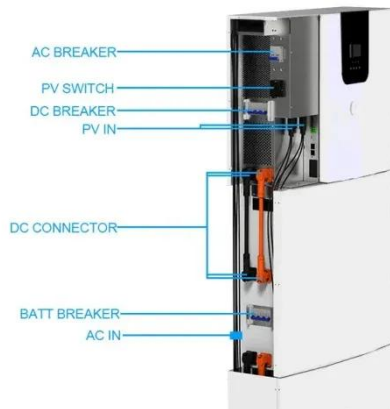

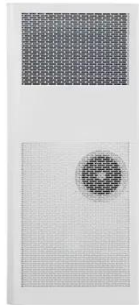

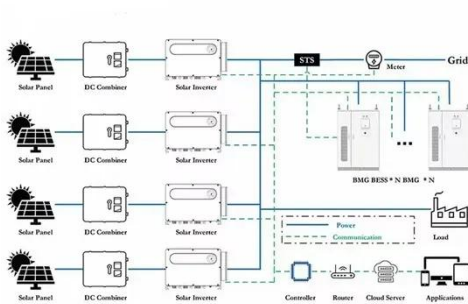
