Currently, we have nearly 8GW of renewable electricity generation capacity installed across the country, with circa 5GW of onshore wind generation and over 2.2GW of solar PV installed, with hydro, biomass, and other small sources also contributing. 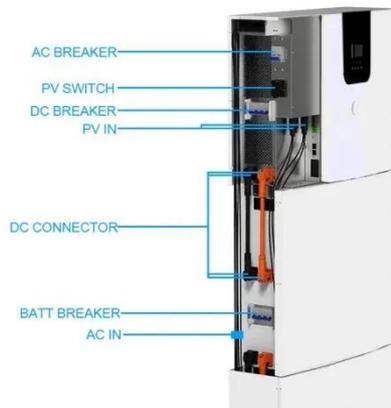




