Overview

Port of Bilbao in Spain has received the green light to construct a photovoltaic solar plant aimed at providing renewable energy for cruise ships docked at two of its cruise terminals, Getxo 2 and Getxo 3. Spain's Bilbao Port Authority has awarded an EUR-11. This project represents a significant step toward implementing a shore power supply system powered by green energy. Spain's Council of Ministers has approved €55.6 million) in funding to electrify the Port of Bilbao, as part of its bid to be carbon neutral by 2050.




