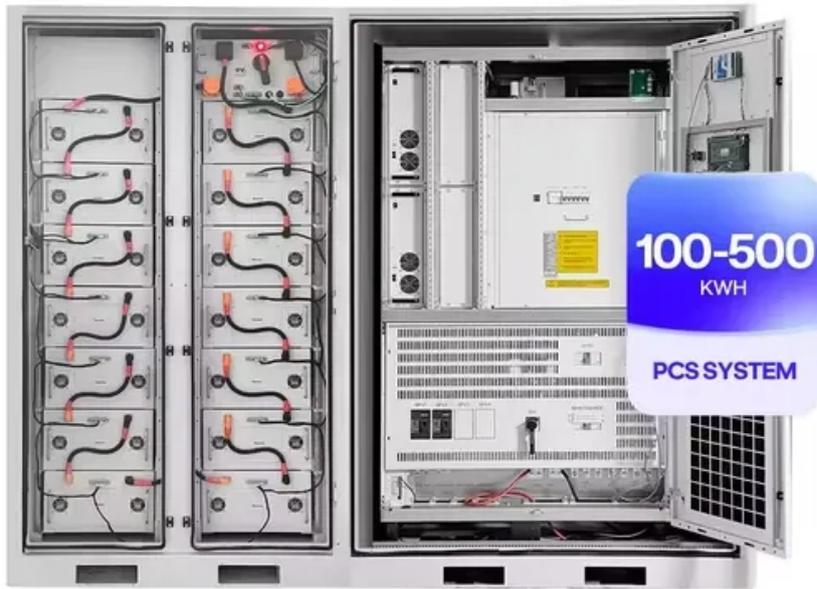


Why were the photovoltaic panels removed again



Overview

Perhaps the solar array had defective solar panels, the manufacturer no longer exists, or the output of an older project is unimpressive compared to the high-efficiency solar panels and equipment readily available today. He took several years to work out what could be installed on the roof of the White. The "Big Beautiful Bill" was signed into law on July 4, ending the 30% residential solar credit after 2025.
